

**LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT
OF
DAVID M. COFFEY**

I, David M. Coffey, of Bowling Green, Kentucky, revoke my former Wills and Codicils and declare this to be my Last Will and Testament.

**ARTICLE I
PAYMENT OF DEBTS AND EXPENSES**

I direct that my just debts, funeral expenses and expenses of last illness be first paid from my estate.

**ARTICLE II
NOMINATION OF EXECUTOR**

I nominate and appoint, Dan Myers, of Bowling Green, Kentucky as the Executor of my estate, without bond or without surety thereon if bond is required. If for any reason, Dan Myers, cannot serve, I nominate my Attorney, John M. Gambrel, of London, Kentucky, to be the Executor, without bond or without surety thereon if bond is required. My executor/alternate executor, in addition to other powers and authority granted by law or necessary or appropriate for proper administration, shall have the right and power to sell any real or personal property that may be included in my estate, without order of court and without notice to anyone.

**ARTICLE III
DISPOSITION OF PROPERTY**

Specific Bequest or Devise:

All personal items will be inventoried on a spreadsheet with the items listed as per room and given to each person as listed hereinafter:

I hereby bequeath or devise the following personal and real property as follows:

1. Masks: To Western Kentucky University with the appropriate place being the Art, International Studies, Museum or Library. If Western Kentucky University cannot utilize said masks, distribute as within paragraph three (3).
2. Inca Pottery (3 pieces): To Adam Dahmer with the intent of never being sold and eventually being donated to Western Kentucky University as requested in the Last Will and Testament of Adam Dahmer.
3. Paintings, Carvings, Folk Art, Hangings, etc.: First choice of one (1) of these items shall be given to John M. Gambrel; however, only one item is to be given to John M.

Gambrel and then to Mitchell Leichhardt, Jerry Baker, and Dan Myers, and only one item to each. The remaining items shall be chosen and distributed, one piece in each rotation, in the following order; Mamma, Daddy, Luis Samayoa, Daryl and Deborah together, Ann and Steve Dahmer together, Danny and Jane Coffey together, Pam Wells, Ann Lloyd, Chuck and Loren Coffey together, Chris Coffey, Adam Dahmer, Jody Dahmer, Andi Dahmer, Kristie Deborah Sloss, Pete Dreisbach, Debbie Gabbard, Samantha Moseley, Travis Meserve, Will Galbreath, and Roger Dennis. This sequence shall be repeated until all items have been distributed. In case of named being deceased, remove name from the list and do not award to their heirs at law or next of kin.

4. The Russian piece of art above the bed in my residential home to Louis Samayoa.
5. Household items, quilts, furniture, rugs, dishes, clothing: First choice of these items shall be distributed in the following order; Mamma, Daddy and then Luis. The remaining items shall be chosen by a place drawing between Dodie, Daryl, Ann, Steve Dahmer, Deborah Coffey, Jane Coffey, Chuck Coffey, Loren Coffey, Andi Dahmer, Jody Dahmer, Adam Dahmer, Pam Wells, Debbie Gabbard, Ann Lloyd, Pete Dreisbach, Ron Eckard, Kristie Guffey, Samantha Moseley, Travis Meserve, Will Galbreath and Roger Dennis. All items are to be chosen in that order and each recipient is encouraged to choose at least three (3) items. Dishes and glasses are to be distributed as sets where applicable and reasonable. Recipients are encouraged to express their requests prior to distribution. In case of named being deceased, remove name from the list and do not award to their heirs at law or next of kin. All other things not wanted are to be given to Latinos including Antonio Echiverria and Mundo Guillen with remains to the Refugee Center. No auction(s) please.
6. All airline, hotel and travel miles to Luis Samayoa. If Luis Samayoa should predecease me, then I bequeath them to Ron Eckard. If Ron Eckard is deceased, I bequeath them to Ann Coffey for expenses of traveling with family OUTSIDE the United States. I will provide a list of the same to accompany my last will and testament and be provided to the executor and attorney.
7. Personal property in the amount of \$5,000.00 to Ron Eckard if alive and still witty, if not alive and witty to my residuary estate and not to his heirs at law or beneficiaries. To Luis Samayoa, I bequeath the sum of \$9,999.00 for current expenses. To Kristie Guffey, I bequeath the sum of \$5,000.00 for Vacation South.
8. Pocket watch in Service One Lockbox to Chuck Coffey, hopefully, never to be sold.
9. All vehicles that I own at my demise to Antonio Echiverria and if he predeceases me then through my residuary estate and not to his heirs at law or beneficiaries.
10. All items in the garage at 1242 Chestnut Street, Bowling Green, Kentucky all items in the garage at 1215 Chestnut Street, Bowling Green, Kentucky and all tools in the basement of 1242 Chestnut, Bowling Green, Kentucky, I hereby bequeath to Santos

Antonio Echeverria, excepting all lawn mowers and weed eaters, I hereby bequeath all lawn mowers and weed eaters to Edmundo Guillen, a/k/a Mundo.

11. Real property shall be distributed as follows:

Real property, known as 516 12th Street, Bowling Green, Kentucky is to be sold and divided pursuant to the terms of the will with Right of First Refusal given to Barbara Stuart. If Right of First Refusal is not exercised by Barbara Stuart, real property is to be sold with the remainder of the property.

Real property, known as 1215 Chestnut Street, Bowling Green, Kentucky shall be sold and the proceeds held in trust. The beneficiary is Santos Antonio Echeverria, and the trustee of the trust will be Luis Samayoa.

Real property, known as 1203, 1235, 1236 Chestnut Street, Bowling Green, Kentucky and 1359 Park Street, Bowling Green, Kentucky shall be sold and proceeds divided pursuant to the terms of the will.

Real property known as 1242 Chestnut Street, Bowling Green, Kentucky and furniture inside them home including the jar above the mantle, I devise to Kristie Broadbent Guffey.

**ARTICLE IV
ALL OTHER PROPERTIES**

All other real property is to be sold privately with David Chandler, Norm Johnson or other selected individual selling at an agreed and equitable price.

I hereby give, devise, and bequeath my tangible or intangible personal property along with the proceeds from the sale of real property as stated above as follows:

One-Fourth (1/4) to the David Coffey scholarship fund at Western Kentucky University, Bowling Green, Kentucky and shall be used for low income first generation college students and is open to qualifying students regardless of major.

One-Tenth (1/10) to Project Hope at Western Kentucky University, Bowling Green, Kentucky.

One-Tenth (1/10) to my nephews and nieces to the used to further or advance their education beyond a Masters Level Degree.

One-Tenth (1/10) to Ron Eckard.

One-Fourth (1/4) to Louis Samayoa.

One-Fifth (1/5) to my siblings, divided equally.

ARTICLE V RESIDUARY ESTATE

If a devisee or legatee dies before the testator, or is dead at the making of this will, leaving issue who survive the testator, such issue shall NOT take the estate devised or bequeathed them and I direct that my residuary estate be distributed to my heirs at law as if I died intestate pursuant to laws of intestate succession in the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

ARTICLE VI MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

A. Paragraph Titles and Gender. The titles given to the paragraphs of this Will are inserted for reference purposes only and are not to be considered as forming a part of this Will in interpreting its provisions. All words used in this Will in any gender shall extend to and include all genders, and any singular words shall include the plural expression, and vice versa, and any pronouns shall be taken to refer to the person or persons intended regardless of gender or number.

B. Body: I request that my remains be donated to the Medical School at University of Louisville, if useful. Otherwise, my cremains are to be spread over the Cumberland River at Highway 90 Bridge outside of Burkesville, Kentucky. A marker is to be established in the Chapel at Western Kentucky University.

C. Liability of Fiduciary. No fiduciary who is a natural person shall, in the absence of fraudulent conduct or bad faith, be liable individually to any beneficiary of my estate, and my estate shall indemnify such natural person from any and all claims or expenses in connection with or arising out of that fiduciary's good faith actions or nonactions of the fiduciary, except for such actions or nonactions which constitute fraudulent conduct or bad faith. No successor trustee shall be obliged to inquire into or be in any way accountable for the previous administration of the trust property.

D. Beneficiary Disputes. If any bequest requires that the bequest be distributed between or among two or more beneficiaries, the specific items of property comprising the respective shares shall be determined by such beneficiaries if they can agree, and if not, by my Executor.

E. No Contest Clause. I direct that any beneficiary under this will who shall contest its admission to probate, appeal from an order admitting it to probate or file a will contest in circuit court shall forfeit his distributive share and the same shall pass into the residue of my estate.

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
