Directions: Answer one of the questions in Section A for 15 points. Answer one of the questions in Section B for 10 points. Answer one of the questions in Section C for 5 points. Your responses should adequately address all aspects of the question. Questions in Section A can be answered in at least 2 pages of typewritten, double-spaced text.
