Call for Previously Published Works for the “Adela Zamudio Award” (2024)

It is a great pleasure for Feministas Unidas Inc. to announce the 2024 call for the “Adela Zamudio Award.” The objective of this award is to recognize the best peer reviewed published work (book, article, or chapter of an edited volume) by a current member of FemUn. The works that can participate in this call must include some of these areas: feminist studies, gender studies, queer studies, transatlantic studies, and studies related to literature and film that combine issues of race and gender. The selection committee is drawn from officers and members of FemUn Inc. and past recipients. The award will be presented during the guaranteed session hosted by FemUn at the MLA Annual Convention, and later the announcement will be posted on the FemUn website.

Call guidelines:

1. The work (book, article, or chapter of a collective book) must have been published between January 1, 2023 and December 31, 2023.
2. The person who applies to this call must be a member of an institution of higher education and be part of FemUn (membership can be paid at the time of submission of the work).
3. The work should be written in English, Portuguese or Spanish.
4. Declaration that this work is not being simultaneously considered for another award.
5. The submission is made using the following Google form: <https://forms.gle/7Jf9z1KbttF4NvrE7> which will request to attach the following documents: a) a CV in PDF format; b) a document in PDF format that includes the following information: name, current affiliation, email, publication data sent (publisher, journal name, pages, etc.); c) the work in anonymous PDF format where no data from either the publication or the person writing it is shown. The selection committee is drawn from officers and members of FemUn and past recipients. FemUn reserves the right not to award the prize in any given year.

Call guidelines:

1. An anonymous unpublished paper (PDF format), between 7,500 to 9,000 words, 1-5 spaced, including notes and works cited and includes notes using the "Editorial Guidelines" of *Ámbitos Feministas*.
2. The graduate student has to be a member of FU (membership can be paid at the time of submission).
3. The paper should be written in English, Portuguese or Spanish.
4. Declaration that this work a) is not being simultaneously considered for another award or for publication in another medium; and b) that the work has not engaged in any form of plagiarism.
5. Call guidelines:

1. For the creative writing award, please submit an anonymous, unpublished work in PDF format with a maximum of 8,000 words. The work should be 1-5 spaced and follow the “Editorial Guidelines” of *Ámbitos Feministas*.
2. For the artistic creation award, please submit an anonymous, unpublished work in PDF format with a file size of less than 100 MB. The work should include a maximum of 5 color images and a brief description (200 words) of the project.
3. The work should be written in English, Portuguese or Spanish.
4. Declaration that this work a) is not being simultaneously considered for another award or for publication in another medium; and b) that the work has not engaged in any form of plagiarism.
5. The submission is made using the following Google form <https://forms.gle/joEnAiyMd8Kvy5j37> which will request to attach the following documents: a) a CV in PDF format; b) a document in PDF format that includes the following information: name, email, title; c) the work in anonymous PDF format where no data from the author.
