3. Describe three factors relating to the setting that you need to consider prior to seeing a client. Discuss how you would address these issues if you had a practice of your own.
4. Discuss appropriate nonverbal communication. How would you use nonverbal communication within both a therapy setting and a nontherapy setting?

### **Section C**

5. Provide a fictitious therapy transcription that includes at least two reflections of content by the therapist and two reflections of emotions by the therapist.

6. Describe at least two different situations in which confidentiality does not appear to be a black and white issue. (3 pts)
