



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
- Hardest class I have taken thus far. However, Locke is such a great professor and is so helpful.

Dr. Locke is a really hard grader which can be frustrating because a lot of the conceptual stuff goes over my head (I'm totally not a math person), but he's good at giving opportunities to gain points back so our grades aren't totally horrid. Overall, while the class has been hard it hasn't been as awful as I thought it would be, which is a lot for a non-math person to admit!


- I love this class. I think Dr. Locke is an amazing professor, and he makes sure that we really understand the content. Super brilliant and very relatable too. I have zero complaints.

- Dr. Locke is always available to help his students. His lectures are very clear and he gives practice examples to help his students better understand the material. His exams are fair and cover the material taught in class. My only critique is that we get no feedback on our projects so moving onto the next project is difficult because we do not know what we did wrong on the previous projects so it is difficult to adjust and do better in the future.
- Dr. Locke's approach to teaching econometrics is wonderful to an undergraduate. While many professors would teach how the individual parts of a car's engine work and how they work, Dr. Locke backs up and looks at what the car can do and how to use the car to get where you need to go. He is quite good at teaching such a tough subject.
- I will say this, he is a great teach, both in how he teaches, and how willing he is to help you even outside of class. I was needing help with my senior assessment and he offered to all of us to come in and see him. You don't know how much help he was to helping figure out how to run my regression. Even with the baby on the way, being willing to help us showed how much he cared.

He understands the material extremely well and provides students endless opportunities to ask questions if something doesn't quite make sense. - Dr. Locke is very conscientious about the course structure and adapts very well to different circumstances which have came up for him this semester and I have still learned a lot from this class.
